Calculating the tax-deductibility of your 2011 contribution

Membership Benefits

As a member of the Montshire Museum of Science, you receive the following benefits:

- 10% discount in the Museum Store.

- Discounts on educational programs.

Under Internal Revenue Service guidelines, the estimated value of the benefits listed above is not substantial; therefore the full amount of your payment is a deductible contribution.

Donor Benefits

Donors who are classified as “Friends” give more than their membership fee. Except for a listing in our annual report, the benefits are the same as for basic members. The value of all “Friends” benefits is insubstantial.

The following benefits are offered to donors of \$200 or more, in addition to all the membership benefits listed above. Donors must reduce the amount of contribution deduction by the fair market value of benefits received.
