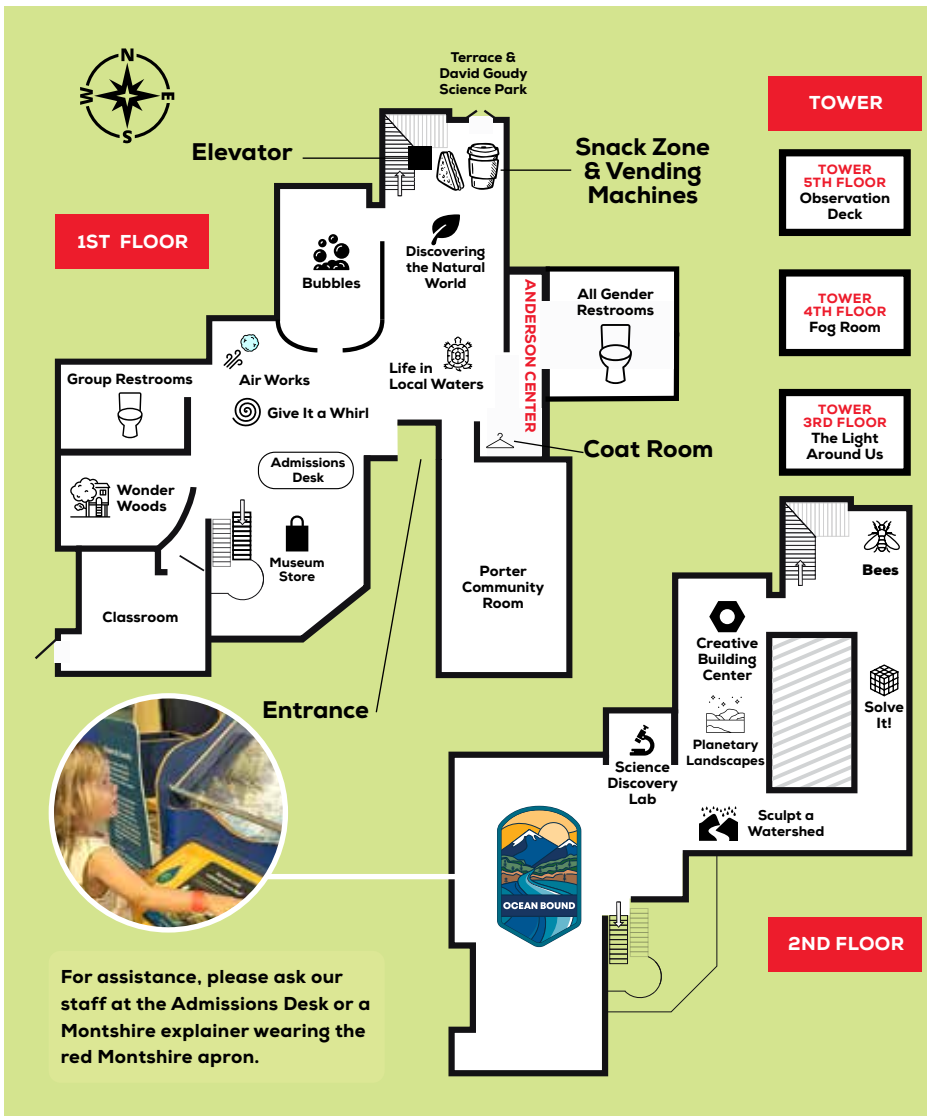

Adults must supervise children and help them make good choices for their age and ability. Front desk staff and Explainers will help reunite bigs with littles.

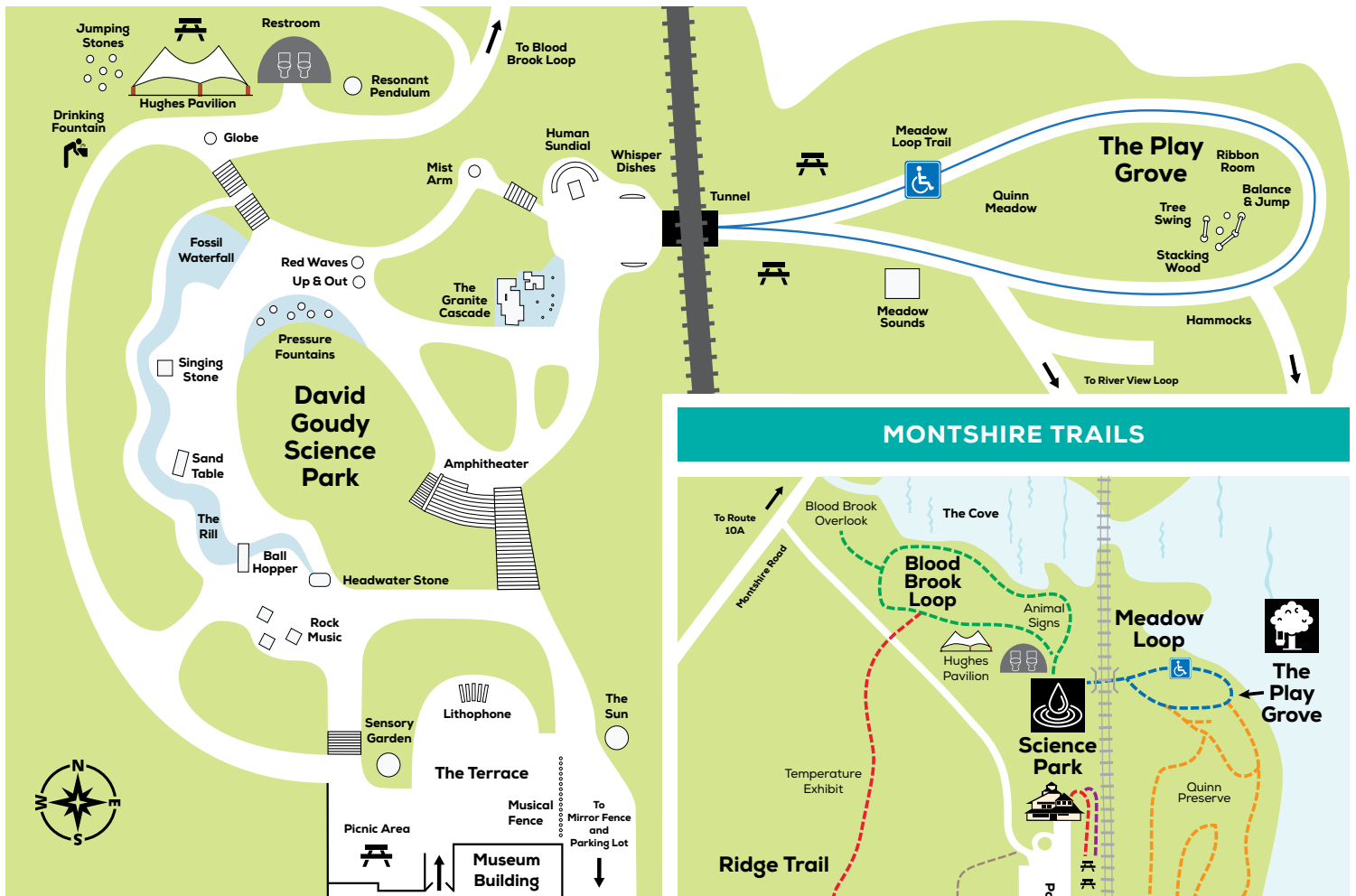
### COMING AND GOING

## OUTDOOR EXPERIENCES AND TRAILS



### Meadow Loop (0.6 mile)

An accessible stroll around a wildlife-filled meadow.



### River Loop (0.8 mile)

A scenic trail with river views.



### Blood Brook Trail (0.4 mile)

A trail with variety: open field, trees grove, cove views.



### Woodland Garden (0.1 mile)

A showcase of native plants with plenty of benches.



### Ridge Trail (1 mile)

A rugged trail with exhibits that explore ecology.



### Planet Walk (3 miles to Pluto and back)

A scale-model journey that travels the solar system.



### David Goudy Science Park

Explore outdoor physics exhibits while playing with sound and sunlight.



### Play Grove

Explore a nature-inspired play area.



### Hughes Pavilion

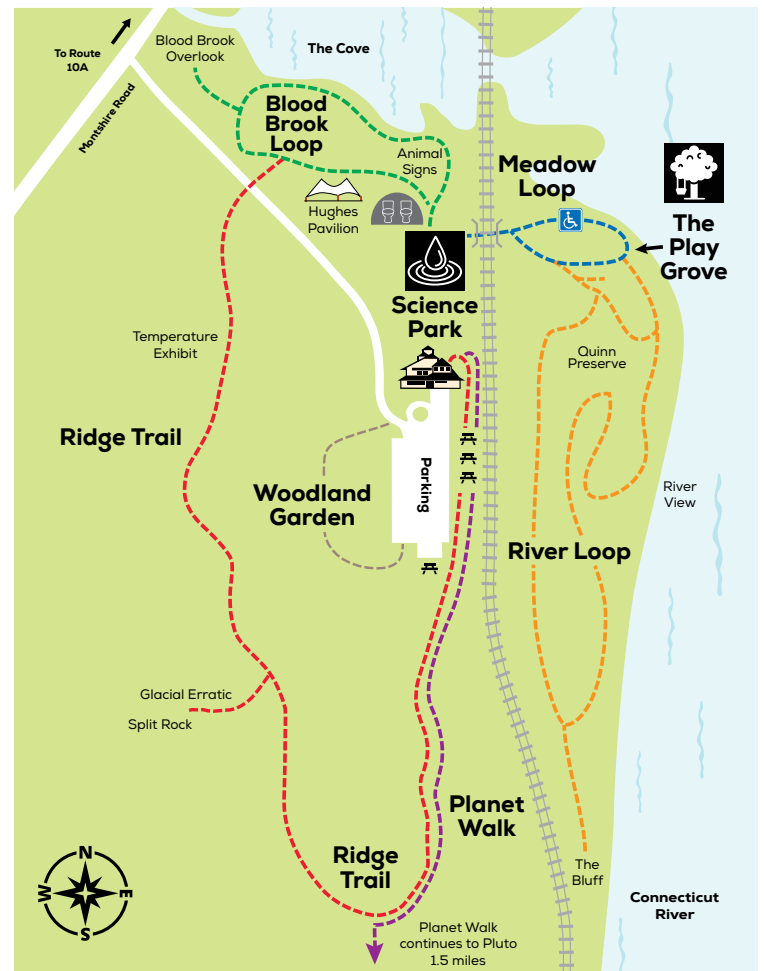
A cool place to rest, and build with Big Blue Blocks.
