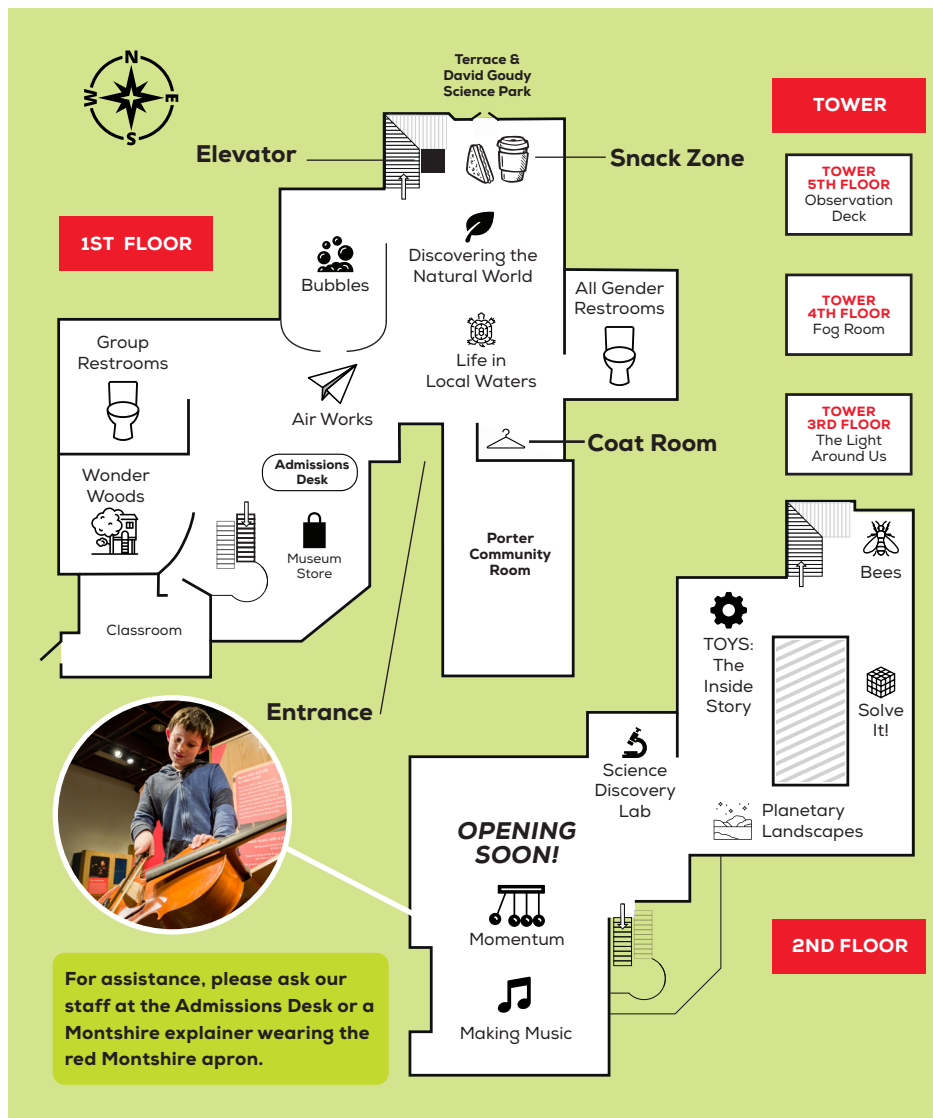

Please stay on trails and leave wildlife undisturbed.

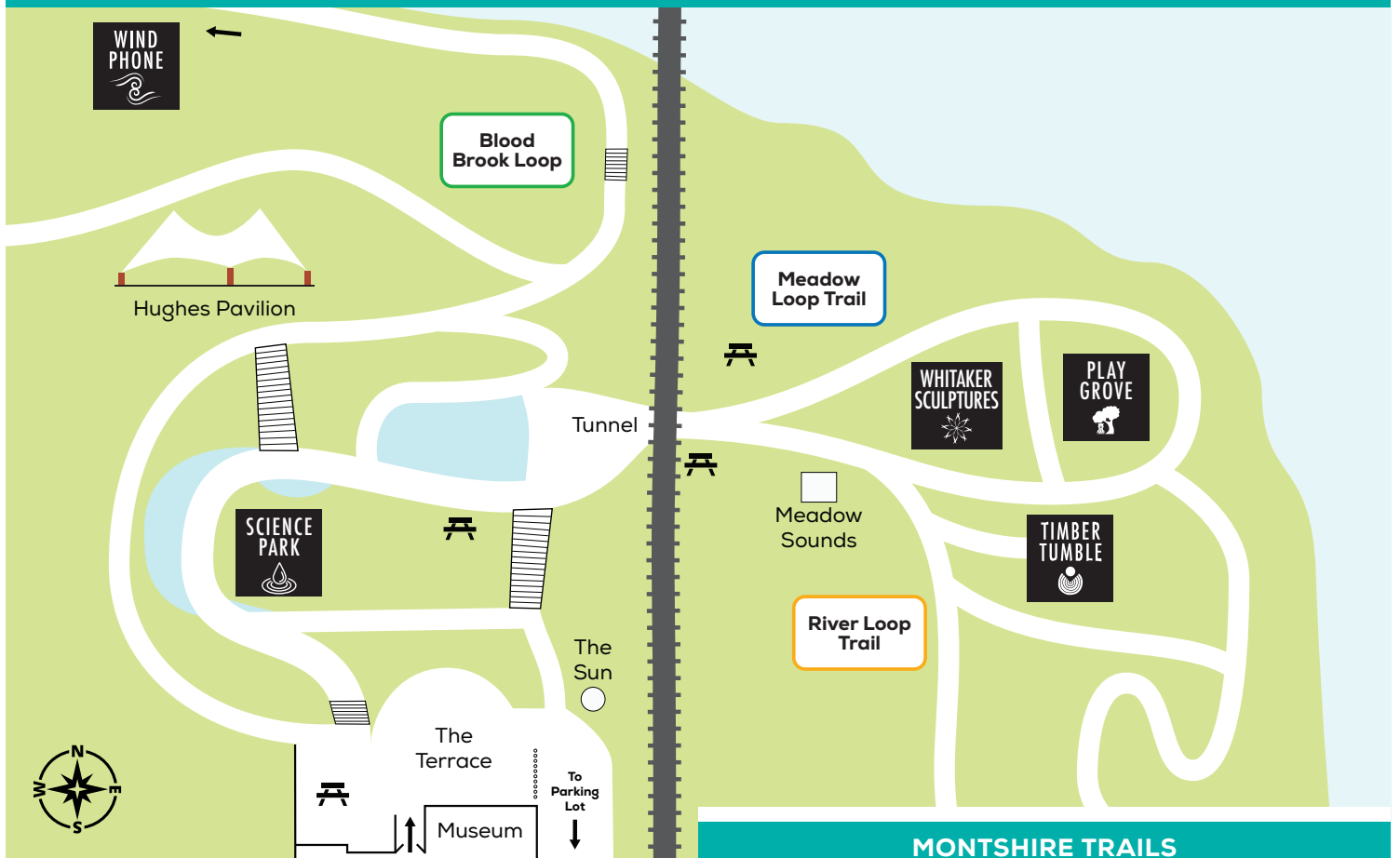
